

New Jersey Clinical Laboratory Improvement Act

New Jersey Clinical Laboratory Improvement Act requires acute care hospitals and clinical laboratories to implement electronic medical records systems that include demographic data entry features for sexual orientation and gender identity (SOGI).

Who is required to train?

- Acute Care Hospitals
- Clinical Laboratories
