Starting 11/10/2023 Bill S1783A, also known as the New York State Long-Term Care LGBTQ+ Bill of Rights establishes certain requirements concerning rights of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender undesignated/non-binary, questioning, gueer, intersex, and HIV-positive residents of long-term care facilities.

Training Requirements

Long-Term Care Facility Administration

Receive training regarding the Long-Term CareBill of Rights

Long-Term Care Facility Staff

Receive LGBTQ+ & HIV cultural competency training within six months of hire and every two years

How can we comply?
