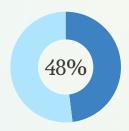

The Silent Divide in Healthcare Access



Social Isolation

45% of LGBTQ+ older adults report feeling a lack of companionship and 48% feel socially isolated.



HIV/AIDS

54% of Americans living with HIV are 50+ years old and at a higher risk of diabetes, hypertension and stroke.



Cognitive Decline

to report cognitive decline that their cisgender or heterosexual peers.



Delayed Care

Nearly 1-5 LGBTQ+ older adults did not seek care for health concerns in the past year.



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The Healthcare Gap



Mental Health

LGBTQ+ elders experience up to 3x higher rates of depression, anxiety, and social isolation compared to their heterosexual peers.



Chronic Conditions

Elevated rates of HIV, diabetes, and cardiovascular disease demand an integrated approach to prevention, risk assessment, and management as interconnected conditions.



Trauma-Informed Care

Lifetime exposure to discrimination and prejudice creates unique psychological needs requiring healthcare providers with specialized cultural competency.

These profound disparities result from decades of institutional barriers and discrimination. Most healthcare providers lack essential training to address these nuanced and complex health challenges.
